Nishijin Sky: Teresita Fernández+HOSOO



HOSOO is pleased to announce their collaboration with American contemporary artist Teresita Fernández for the exhibition “Nishijin Sky” set to open on 2 October 2014 at the Kyoto University of Art & Design. For the exhibition, Teresita Fernández, who is mostly known for her large-scale sculptures and site-specific artworks, has partnered with HOSOO and curator Kayo Tokuda to create a luminous golden waterscape of ebb and flow engulfed in atmospheric darkness. The result is a freestanding landscape sculpture that can be enjoyed and viewed from all sides. The aim of the “Nishijin Sky” exhibition is to showcase the meeting between contemporary art and traditional crafts and to encourage experimentation and collaboration across cultures and disciplines.
